

MONSTER SPRAY



Vaporizes **MONSTERS** on Contact!

Have your child spray the **MONSTER SPRAY** wherever and whenever needed, especially right before bedtime!

Your child will then feel safe and secure knowing that the Monster's have been vaporized, **INSTANTLY!!** And, the monsters will not return because monsters hate the sweet, flowery smell of the **MONSTER SPRAY!**

This label has been designed to cover a bathroom air freshener. Save \$\$\$... buy a freshener at your local \$1.00 store!

Instructions:

1. Print your Monster Spray label. (Use cardstock for best results).
2. Trim the left, vertical side of the label, where the white area meets the label's gray background.
3. Make note of the position of the spray nozzle or find the red dot (on the rim of the can) that indicates the proper sprayer direction and line that up with the center of the label.
4. BEFORE cutting anything else, test-fit the label. To do this, align the top edge of the label with the top edge of the can. (If your spray can has a removable cap, be sure to leave it in place for this step.)
5. Holding the label in place with one hand, make a "tick mark" where the back edges of the label overlap, then run your thumbnail (or a pencil) along the bottom edge of the can to designate the excess.
6. Remove the label from the can and fold it along the mark you made to designate the bottom of the can. Trim along that line.
7. Fold the vertical edge of the label $\frac{1}{2}$ inch from your tick-mark (allowing $\frac{1}{2}$ inch for overlap) and trim along that line.
8. Now, place two small pieces of double-stick tape on back side of the label. Place both pieces near the center, align one along the top edge and one along the bottom edge.
9. Align the label on the spray can (be sure the center of the design is aligned with the spray nozzle) and press to adhere.
10. Check to make sure label is properly aligned (squared so edges align evenly), then place small pieces of double-stick tape along the entire left-edge of the label, underneath the white text.
11. Place the freshener on its side and gently roll along a hard surface until the label wraps completely around the can and the label is adhered completely.

NOTE: Moisture (like wet hands or splashes) will cause the ink on the label to run. To prevent this, cover the label with clear plastic (such as Contact Paper®) or just keep the label dry. ☺
